Monday, May 12, 2025 Day 3

8:15-8:45- PLC/ get ready for the day

8:45-9:05- Homeroom

Students will come in and unpack for the day. They should also make lunch choices. You will take attendance. 5th grade does announcements. You can send the students to Mrs. Horst's class to do announcements. Send attendance and lunch count to the office. Students should stay quiet. They may have morning work in their google classroom.

9:05-9:25- ELA 5-1 foundations

Instruction- Go over what makes a hero on page 206. Discuss what characteristics heroes have and who are some more famous heroes. Talk about how some people can be a hero for a whole group of people like Harriet Tubman and some may be only for some people, like someone you know personally. Have students make a chart. Go over some of things they put and why.

For the 5 clue challenge- students will need to have their chromebooks. On Google classroom play the 5 clue challenge video. It will play 5 clues. Pause the video after each clue. Give the kids time to "research" on their computers. Maybe 3 minutes for each clue. They can put down the same place each time or they can put a different place after each clue. Collect their papers for the 5 clue challenge. Then play the end of the video where it tells the answer.

Read the side bar on page 207- meet the author. Then read the background to the story. Discuss where the setting of our story is? Who had it right on the 5 clue challenge?

9:25-9:45 ELA 5-1 Read and respond

Work session- Go over the vocabulary words. Have students write them on the paper with their hero information. Have them talk about what each word means. Have them fill in the words and meanings on the worksheet. Tell them they will have a quiz on the vocab words. The vocab words are reef, phosphorus, vulnerable, lagoon, pursuit. Have them read pages 208-212. You can ask the questions to the side as you read. If you don't get to all of those pages just write down where you left off.

Closing- Have students think to themselves what Mako's boat would look like. Have them then draw a picture of what they see in their minds. Then have them get with a partner and compare pictures. Talk about why their pictures may have some things that are the same and some that are different. Show students an example of the boat.

What doesn't get done before special you can do after special.
